 so if you have a heart for young people and would like to serve in this group, please get in contact.

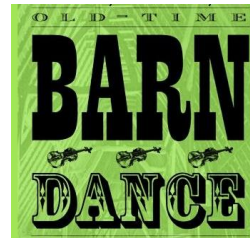
