



This year, our Harvest gifts will be going to Colindale Foodbank.

'We don't think anyone in our community should have to face going hungry. That's why we provide three days' nutritionally balanced emergency food and support to local people who are referred to us in crisis. We are part of a nationwide network of foodbanks, supported by The Trussell Trust, working to combat poverty and hunger across the UK.'

Because those running the foodbank know that crisis can strike anyone and they also understand how difficult it can be to think about walking through a foodbank door, foodbank volunteers aim to welcome everyone who comes to the foodbank with compassion, kindness and a listening ear.

If you have forgotten to bring your Harvest Food today, don't worry! You can still bring tins etc into Church tomorrow or Tuesday morning before 9.30am.

Alternatively you can drop in direct to the Foodbank at Trinity Church Northwest Centre, Grahame Park Way, NW9 5QY on Tuesdays and Thursdays, or look out for Foodbank deposit trolleys in your local supermarket. (e.g. Waitrose, Langstone Way, or Tesco, Brent Cross).
